Ansell's unique GAMMEX® PI Plus Glove-in-Glove™ System offers pre-donned outer and inner glove double gloving protection in one easy package. The 2-color glove system is important for early breach identification.

CLOSED SELF-DONNING STERILE TECHNIQUE



- Perform surgical hand antisepsis and don sterile gown. Follow the recommended closed gloving method:
 - Keep hands covered by the gown sleeves.
 - Unfold the packet and open the inner wrap by grasping the inner folds.



Glove fingers will be pointing away and 'R' for right glove and 'L' for left glove on gloves cuffs will be visible.



With hands still in gown, using opposite hand, remove the first set of gloves by grasping the folded cuff edge.



Hold hand-oriented palm-up and place glove writing-side down.
Using your thumb, grasp the underside of the glove cuff, and with your opposite hand, grab the top edge of the glove cuff.



Pull and stretch it over the opening of the gown so that it is covering the cuff entirely.



Slide and move fingers into gloves by gently pulling up the glove cuff and gown sleeve together.



Repeat the procedure with the gloved hand, for the second set of gloves.

Pull and stretch gloves completely over the cuff. Slide and move your fingers into the gloves.



With the Glove-in-Glove system donned, you can attend to finer adjustments without risk of contamination.



Inspect the gloves for perforations or tears.
