

WHAT IS THE ACT PROGRAM?

The ACT Environmental Impact Factor Ecolabel from My Green Lab provides scientists and procurement specialists with thirdparty verified details on the environmental impact of lab products.

The Label emphasizes Accountability, Consistency, and Transparency (ACT) communicating the details of product manufacturing, energy sourcing, product content, resource use, packaging, durability, and product end-of-life recycling options. This facilitates product comparisons and more sustainable purchasing choices. ACT-labeled items have been independently audited by SMS Collaborative, LLC, and are published in a publicly available database by My Green Lab.

USING THE ACT LABEL

The criteria and methodology for the ACT Label, also known as the Environmental Impact Factor (EIF) criteria, were developed with input from industry experts, including scientists, sustainability and procurement professionals, and product manufacturers.

As of 2024, more than 1,300 lab products have received an ACT Label, with many more products to come, and over 40 manufacturers have engaged in the ACT auditing process. This has made the ACT Label from My Green Lab the most comprehensive, useful, and transparent ecolabeling program in the life sciences industry.
